**HELPFUL REMINDERS AND COMMON SITE RULES & REGULATIONS AT A GLANCE**

Camp/group leaders must ensure that all in their charge are aware of any of the following points that may affect them:

**SAFETY & HYGIENE**

- Read and sign the Fire / Emergency Precautions Notice - The emergency assembly point is the car park.
- Confirm location of first aid arrangements.
- **The footbridge over the motorway is a restricted area unless supervised by a leader or adult.**
- Keep within the site boundary. (Refer to site boundary map)
- Do not climb over fences; there may be something dangerous / delicate on the other side.
- Do not interfere with site equipment or machinery unless instructed to do so.
- Keep to the on site vehicle speed limit of 10mph.
- Vehicles **MUST** be parked in the designated official car parking areas. Parking on access roads or grassed areas is not permitted unless instructed by a warden. Access for emergency vehicles must be assured at all times.
- A leader or adult from your group must supervise use of the Low Ropes Course / Activity Play Area.
- Parental consent is required for Scouts under 18 to take part in rifle shooting activities.
- Washing crockery / cutlery is not allowed at the water container filling points or in wash hand basins. (Use the designated areas.)
- No visitor's dogs are allowed on site except guide dogs for the disabled.
- Camp rubbish / refuse to be bagged and binned in the container located adjacent to the car park.
- Put only litter in the litterbins. (Not camp refuse / rubbish!!)
- The site Alcohol Policy is in line with Scout Fact Sheet FS185092 which advises that any event attended by persons under 18 years of age should adopt good practice as follows: -
  1. At any one time at least two adults depending on the size and nature of the event, should not consume alcohol.
  2. Any adults who do consume alcohol should not interact with young people and should be off duty.
  3. Adults should not consume alcohol in the presence of under 18 year olds.
  4. Where possible, adults should consume alcohol in an area not accessible to under 18 year olds.
  5. Adults who do consume alcohol should behave in a responsible manner at all times.

**GENERAL**

- Safeguard your valuables. The centre is not liable for losses due to theft.
- No loud noise after 10.30 –consider your neighbour.
- Return trolleys to Activity barn.

**ENVIRONMENT**

- Observe the country code.
- No wet / dry pits to be dug.
- No cutting or felling of trees, shrubs or bushes.
- Conserve water

**FIRES**

- Use alter fires for open fires. Earth fireplaces only allowed in designated areas
- No excessively large fires
- Be careful of all wood piles - stout footwear to be worn
- Return unused wood to the wood pile
- Return alter fires to the storage area adjacent to the Activity barn
- Ensure ashes are completely extinguished and disposed of in the container located adjacent to the car park.
